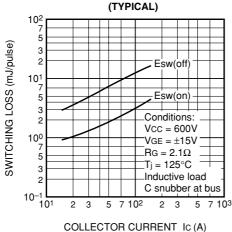

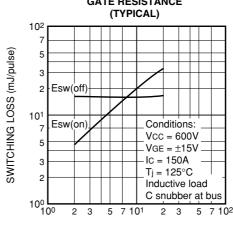

## SWITCHING LOSS vs. **COLLECTOR CURRENT**

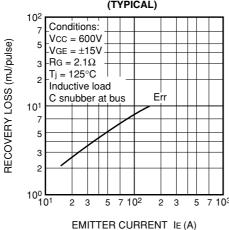


SWITCHING LOSS vs. **GATE RESISTANCE** 

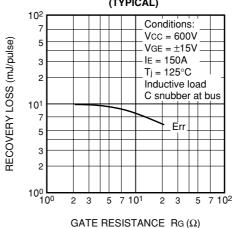


GATE RESISTANCE RG  $(\Omega)$ 

### **RECOVERY LOSS vs. IE** (TYPICAL)



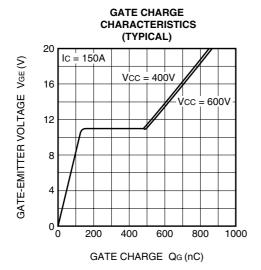
### RECOVERY LOSS vs. **GATE RESISTANCE** (TYPICAL)
